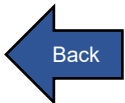


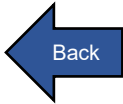

Please use this sobriety community support as a tool in your toolbox to aid in your alcohol and drug sobriety journey. Here are the guidelines to ensure a safe and constructive environment for everyone:

### Participation Agreement:

- **Respect Everyone:** Be inclusive and respectful to all members, regardless of their background, experiences, or opinions. We value diversity and promote non-discriminatory behavior. Furthermore, no forms of harassment, hate speech, or personal attacks are allowed.
- **Privacy and Confidentiality:** All information shared here is confidential. Do not share personal details of other members outside the group. Respect people's privacy.
- **Constructive Feedback:** Provide feedback and engage in discussions in a constructive manner. Avoid negativity and focus on offering helpful feedback and insights.
- **No Medical Advice:** This group is not a substitute for professional medical or mental health advice. Please consult with qualified professionals for your personal needs. In a crisis, call or text 988. Medical Emergency call 911.
- **Compliance with Laws and Policies:** Adhere to all applicable laws, regulations, and group policies. Do not engage in any illegal activities or promote harmful behavior.
- **Reporting:** If you encounter behavior that violates these guidelines, promptly report it to the immediate attention of a SoberCalc Community Support Owner or Appointed Admin. Don't feed the trolls or otherwise perpetuate conflict in the main chat.
- **Stay Sober:** We understand that recovery is a process, and everyone's journey is unique. This group is intended for individuals committed to alcohol and drug abstinence. Posts suggesting or encouraging drinking, using, moderation, and harm reduction are unwelcome. We also want participants to refrain from posting while drunk or high.



### Participation Agreement (continued):



- **Use Your Real First Name:** Sharing your first name helps create a sense of personal connection, but sharing your last name is optional. Making your phone number public is also your personal choice. Please be cautious when sharing personal information with other members.
- **No Spam or Marketing:** This group is not for self-promotion or advertising. Do not post commercial content or unsolicited messages.
- **Updates to Terms:** Participants continued use of SoberCalc Community Support implies acceptance of the updated terms as they occur.
- **Report Issues:** If you witness or experience any violation of these guidelines, please report it immediately to the group owner or admin(s). We take reports seriously and will address them promptly.
- **Moderation:** The group Owner or Admin(s) have the right to moderate content and remove inappropriate posts or participants.
- **Consequences:** Violation of these guidelines may result in a warning, temporary ban, or permanent removal from the group, at the discretion of the owner or admin(s).

### How to report a problem:

Within the group chat, click on the SoberCalc Community Support group name. Scroll down to see the list of members and select a person with Owner or Admin next to their name. Tap the chat bubble on the left of their profile to open a direct chat with them. Explain your concern. Please allow 48 hours for a reply.

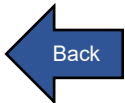
